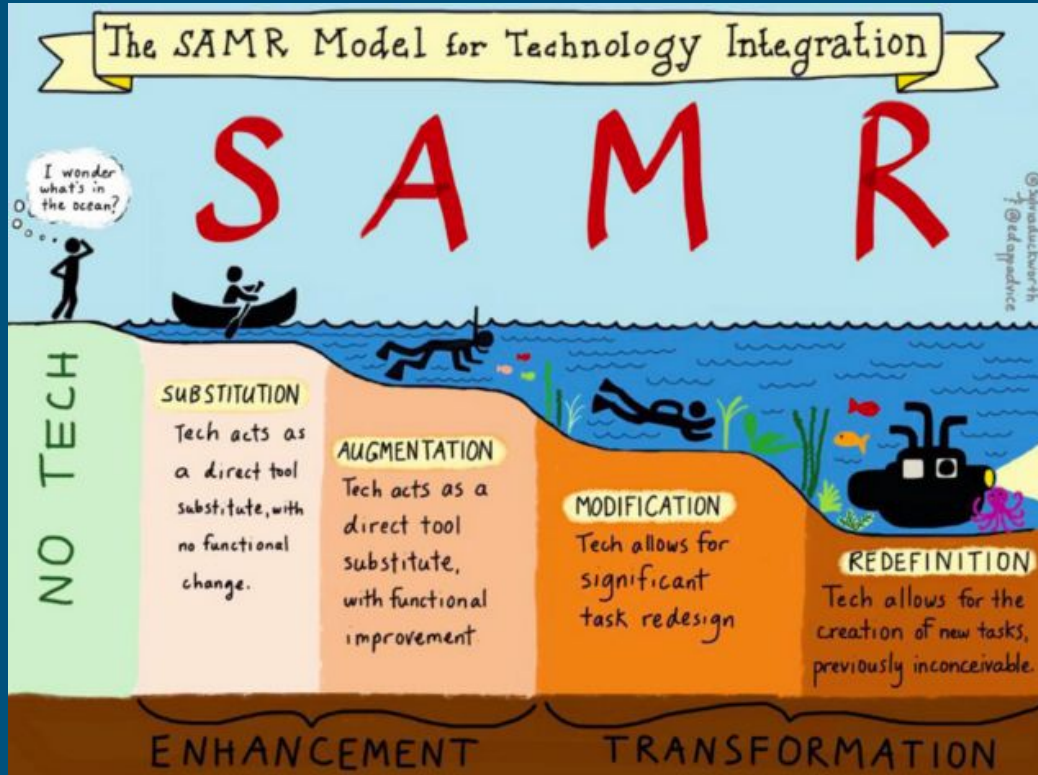
# 21st Century Education

- 21st Century Education: Collaboration, Creativity, Critical thinking, and Communication.

# SAMR



- **SAMR** is the standard in which you will determine how effective technology will be in your lesson.
- Practice and start with Substitution and Augmentation
- **Goal:** to be in Modification and Redefinition

- Power Button
- Volume + and -

- Hold down apps to rearrange them
- Create Folders
- 5 most used apps on the bottom.





# Evernote

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- Make Notebooks
- Search through your notes
- Make lists, bullet points
- Present
- Insert photos, PDFs and other documents within the note.

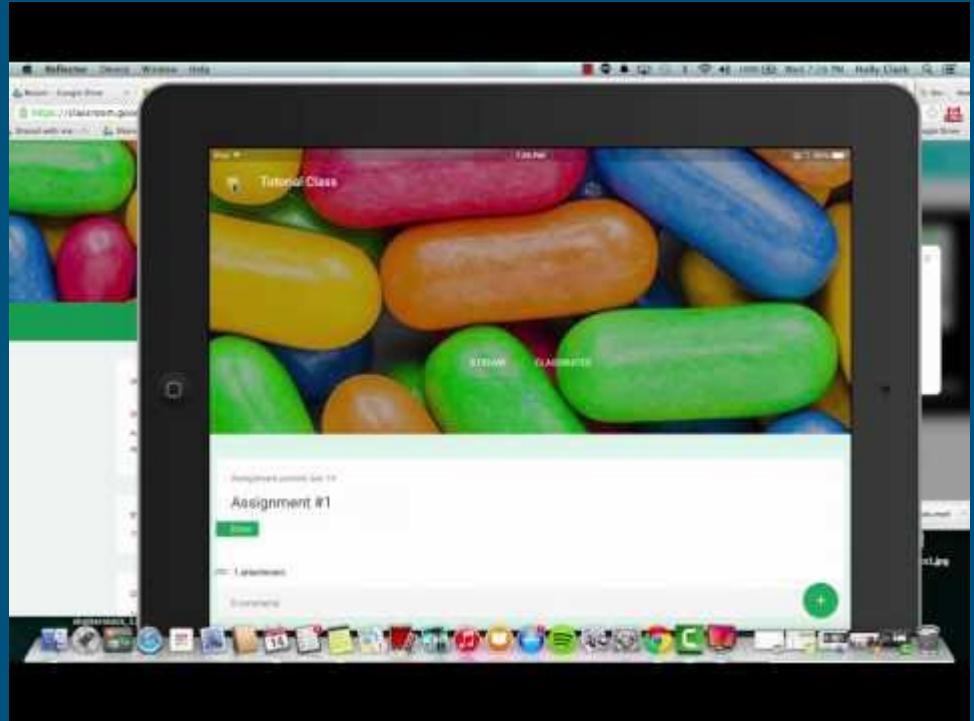


# Google Apps for Ed - Classroom, Docs, Forms

- Your school needs to be registered with Google Apps
- Keep track of assignments
- Look who turned in assignments
- Make announcements

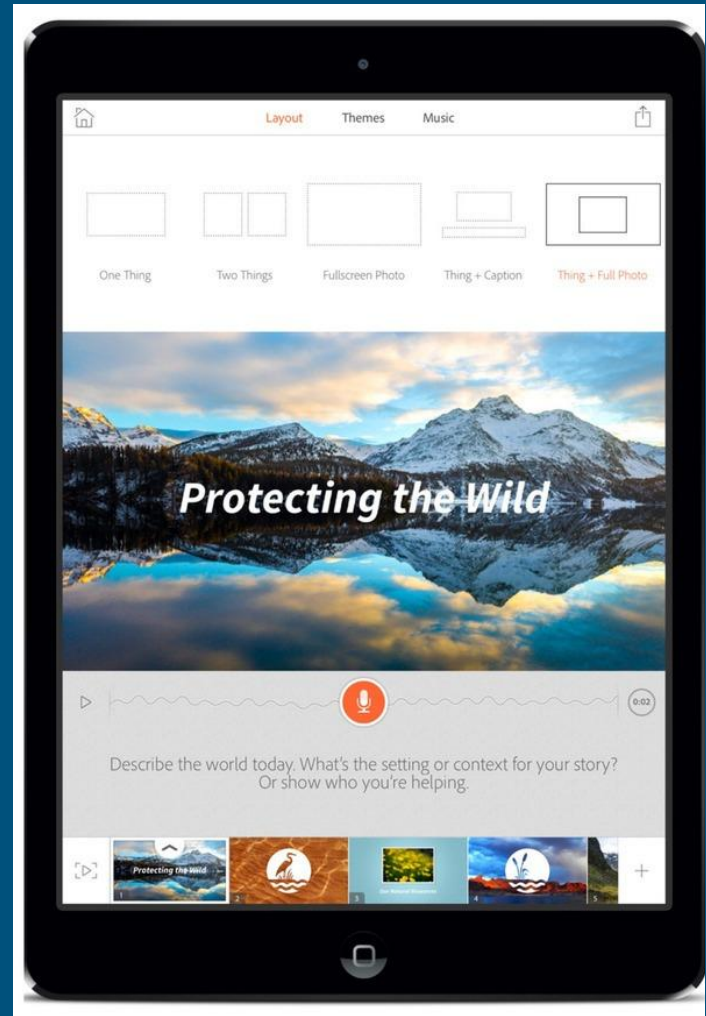

# Adobe Voice

- iPad ONLY
- Best for:
  - tutorials & *short* video projects (promos, storytelling, practicing and evaluating oral competency)
- 4 Components
  - **Layout:** image, words, both
  - **Themes:** color scheme/font
  - **Music:** background song
  - **Voice:** record line by line

# Tips & Tricks

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## Less room for creativity

- professional-looking without intense editing
- cannot change themes
- can upload music

## Viewing videos

- Google Chrome & Safari
- less glitchy with fewer tabs open on browser
- More issues reported with Internet Explorer & Firefox

## Recording

- hold record button for 3 short seconds before and after speaking
- one line per slide (10 seconds of content)

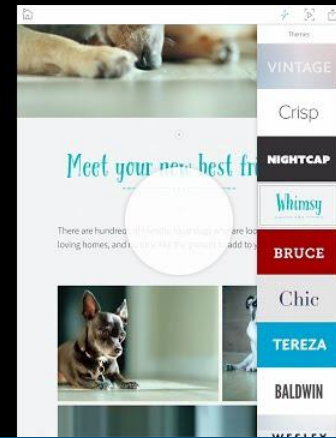
## Best options for sharing content

- Save to camera roll
- Share by email
- Public Adobe Cloud account
- Students must be signed into that account when they publish video

# Adobe Slate (iPad only)

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- Tell a story (any subject!)
- Brochures
- Signs
- Create a flyer
- Learn about design
- Create props for a scene
- Build tutorials
- Design pamphlets for a play

# QR Codes

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- Quick Response Code
- Creating QR codes
  - Static- content cannot be changed
- Most useful for:
  - surveys, stations/treasure hunts, interactive passive boards, going paperless
- Readable
  - Smart Phones: QR Code Reader

# Plickers

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- Great for classes that have limited technology in the classroom.
- Print out papers with a code
- Create formative assessments and scan the papers to gather feedback.





# Aurasma (Laptop and iPad)

- 5 ways to use Aurasma in the classroom.
- Yearbook (PMA won an award for this)
- Scan and show how to do a math problem.
- Showcase music and talent
- Have students recite a poem or speech
- No longer than 1 minute per each Aurasma
- Make your own Aurasma account and start!
- Aura will only show with Aurasma App.
- You MUST follow the Aurasma account to see the Aura
- Laptop creation is easier than in iPad.
